



The Pottroff and Logan - Shop Door Scholarship Fund was established in 2021 for the purpose of awarding a scholarship to two college bound senior students who have taken classes in “The Shop” while attending Horton High School. Larry Pottroff and Jay Logan have dedicated a combined 65 years (Mr. Pottroff 36 years and Mr. Logan 29 years) to teaching the students of Horton High School the hands on skills related to metal fabrication, woodworking, ag mechanics, animal science, horticulture, drafting, and residential construction. Over the years they have impacted thousands of students in a fun and safe shop setting where many learned skills that would lead them into careers after graduation. This scholarship was created to honor their contribution to the students and patrons of the South Brown County Schools and to provide opportunities for Horton High School students continuing their education after graduation.

Up to two \$1,000 scholarships are available for the 2026 academic year.

Criteria:

- Graduating senior of Horton High School
- Must have taken a minimum of two semesters of classes in “The Shop”
- GPA which demonstrates reasonable expectation of success in career field
- Must attend an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, or a vocational school during the Fall 2026 semester
- **Applications are due by April 15, 2026 and should be returned to the Horton High School Counselor, Steve Stallbaumer.**

Scholarship Award – The Pottroff and Logan – Shop Door Scholarship Fund Selection Committee will review applications and the recipient will be announced at the COMUS Night. Payment will be sent directly to the college or university after all necessary documentation has been submitted to the Greater Manhattan Community Foundation.
